While working on this project I did the following:

- Implemented live chat with WebSockets, which is available while users are watching a video.
- Extended chat with multiple features such as: sharing gifs, automatic saving of chat message drafts, saving scroll position, emojis, chat message pending, rejected, and accepted states to indicate request status and implemented notifications for chat messages.
- Used Giphy API.
- Styled components following the provided design.
- Various bug fixes and performance improvements.
